Durlston's rocks tell a key chapter in the formation of the Jurassic Coast World Heritage Site. In Durlston Bay, the remains of tiny prehistoric mammals found within the layers of Purbeck Limestone reveal the story of life 135 million years ago.

A Wealth of Wildlife
More than 3,000 species of wildlife have been found on Durlston's National Nature Reserve. Bustling seabird colonies, rare orchids, migrant birds, flower-filled meadows and beautiful butterflies mean there's always something new to discover.

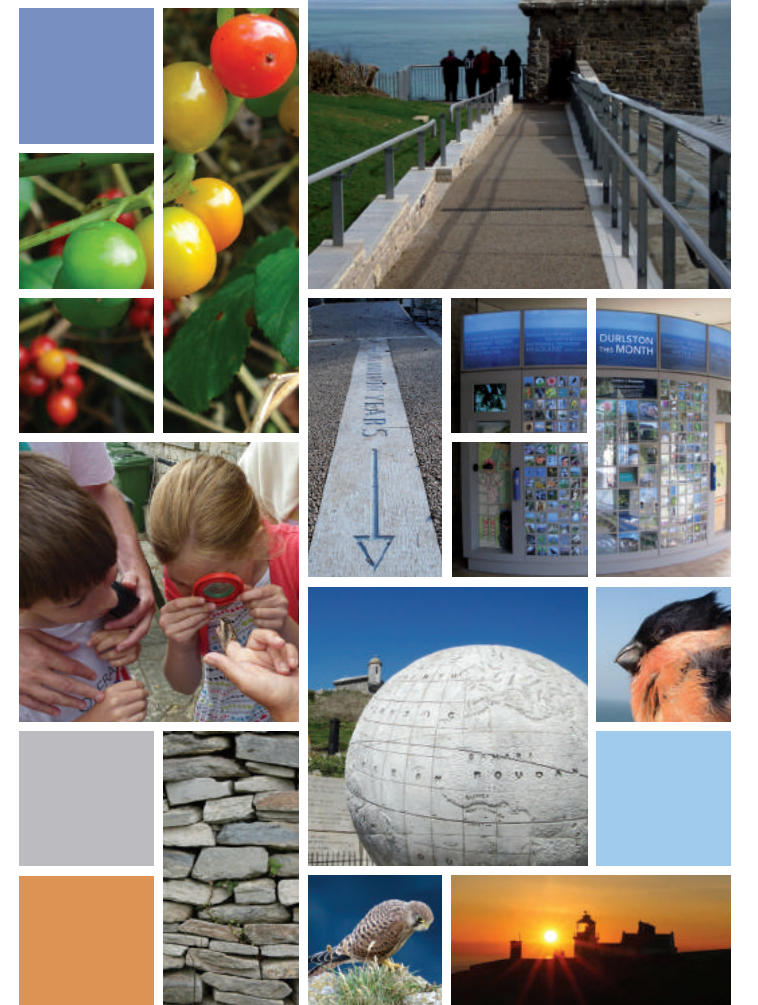

A Victorian Legacy

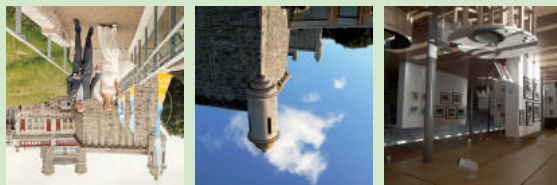

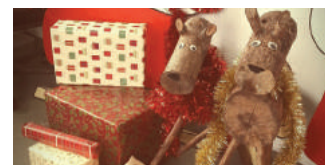
